## HOMEWOPK

- Homework set is consistent throughout the school based on feedback from parents.
- Children will receive 30 minutes of maths and 30 minutes of English each week and a 'topic' based task for each half term.
- We very much encourage a 'reading for pleasure' culture.
- It is vital that your child reads at home with an adult regularly and reads a variety of texts. There is a reading with your child guide school website to help.
- NEW MATHS HOMEWORK BOOK - Trial to consolidate learning covered in class.
- Homework club is on a Wednesday lunchtime.


## Homework will be set on a Monday and handed in by Friday.



- Teacher assessment is ongoing throughout the year.
- We track the children using age related expectations in ALL subjects
- Assessment tracked using a decimal system
- NFER assessments at the end of the year to confirm teacher assessment judgements.
