




Meet The Team

Curriculum




- Autumn Term: Ancient Greeks

This year, we are following a new scheme called 'White Rose' which has been trialed over the past year. This will be tailored to the ability of all children in the class.





English

- 3 Stars and a Wish - system of feedback marking
- House Point - given as reward for good behaviour/work
- Marble - given as a class reward system, once the jar is full, then they are rewarded with a class treat.



Homework

- Homework set is consistent throughout the school based on feedback from parents.
- Children will receive 30 minutes of maths and 30 minutes of English each week and a 'topic' based task for each half term.
- We very much encourage a 'reading for pleasure' culture.
- It is vital that your child reads at home with an adult regularly and reads a variety of texts. There is a reading with your child guide on the school website to help.






Homework

Assessment




- Teacher assessment is ongoing throughout the year.
- We track the children using age related expectations in **ALL** subjects
- Assessment tracked using a decimal system
- NFER assessments at the end of the year to confirm teacher assessment judgements.
