#### Impact of SPG spending

Evaluation of spending for the academic year 2014-15 shows

- a) High quality PE curriculum throughout the school delivered by fully qualified sports coaches. In addition, there will be CPD opportunities the sports coaches will offer to the staff to keep them up-skilled.
- b) The PE Co-ordinator has successfully planned for and taken children to the following inter-sports activities, we have also provided time for a HLTA to provide administration support:

Year 5-6 have attended Sports hall Athletics - January,

Gifted and Talented sports at Broadwater School - March

Children attended Godalming and district Swimming Gala - March

District Sports - July

c) 6 children have received assisted funding to ensure they are able to access the Year 6 residential trip to United Kingdom Sailing Academy, Isle of Wight\*

Due to moving the year 6 residential to the autumn term from September 2015, there will be 2 trips to UKSA in 1 financial year for the first year.

#### Anticipated spend for 2015-16

 From September 2015 the entire PE curriculum will be delivered by fully qualified sports coaches. There will be further opportunities for staff CPD which will run on a rolling programme each term. The provision will be monitored by both the headteacher and the PE subject leader
