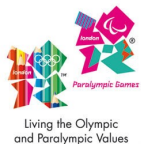
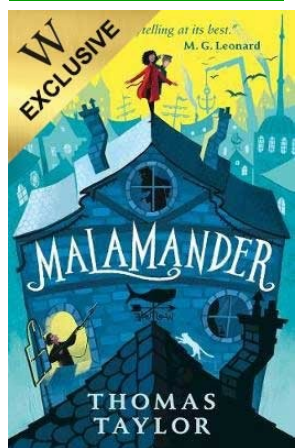
### Mobile Phones
