

<u>COVID Update</u>
With the number of local cases continuing to rise we must continue to be vigilant. We have sent letters out to classes who have been affected by positive cases. This letter will be resent after ten days should there continue to be new cases within the class. Current guidance can be found <u>here</u>. If your child is showing any COVID symptoms they should self-isolate straight away and take a PCR test as soon as possible. Tests can be booked via <u>this link</u>. Following a negative PCR test result they can return to school. Confirmed positive case numbers continue to be small across the school and it is imperative the school is made aware of positive test outcomes as soon as possible. Unless there are symptoms in children and they are absent whilst awaiting PCR outcomes, the children must attend school otherwise risk being logged as an unauthorized absence as insisted by the local authority. Though not a requirement for junior age children, Lateral Flow Tests are readily available if you feel this is necessary.

<u>Christmas Carol Assemblies</u>
We hope to showcase our year group carol assemblies outside to parents later this term. We have amended the start time to 9.15am each morning to allow parents dropping siblings at other schools time to arrive. Each year group will focus on the theme of Forgiveness. We are asking that parents wear face coverings, carry out lateral flow tests before attending (obviously not attending if there is a positive result) children will be performing under the canopy on the front playground.
