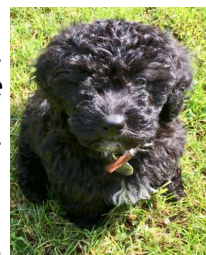

### Digby

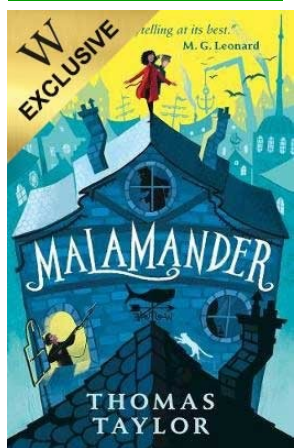

### Trim Trail

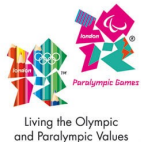
You may have noticed our new trim trail which will hopefully be open to the children on Monday. They have all been itching to have it completed after seeing it gradually erected over the course of the week!
