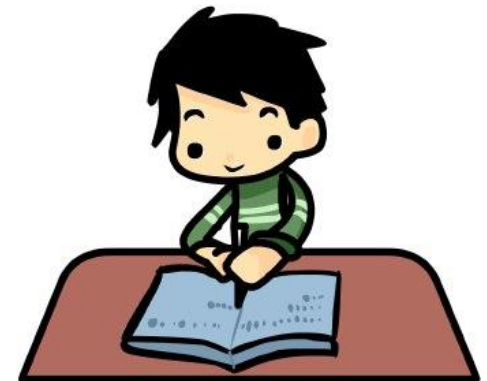

This week I have found PE hard as I had to bounce a basketball and I have never done that before. I have also found it tricky to remember where I sit in my different lessons.

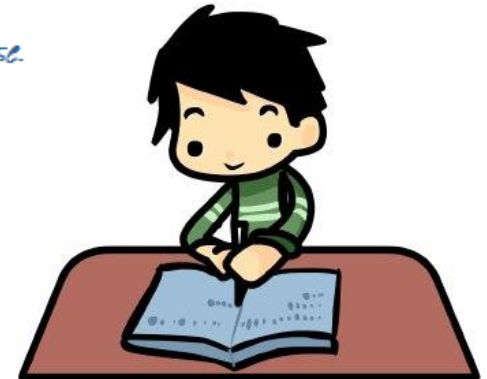
Adjectives to describe my week

Safeguarding and appointments

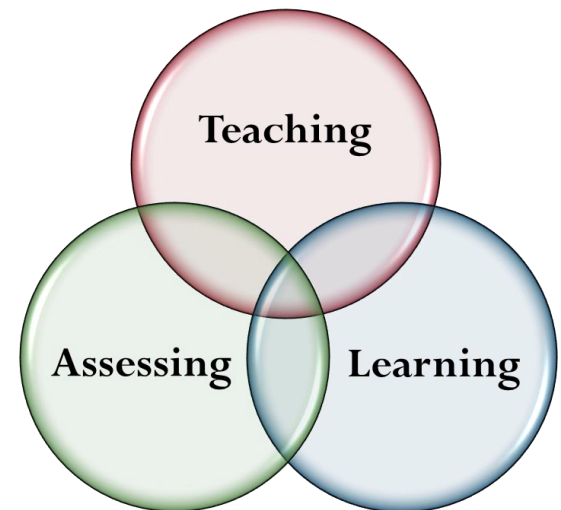
- If you are coming into school, adults must use the front door and report to reception. Please do not come in through the cloakrooms.

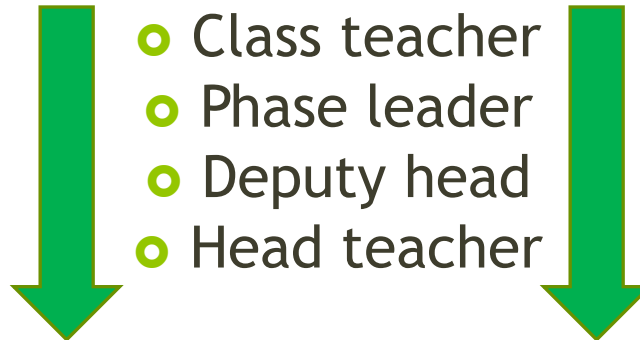

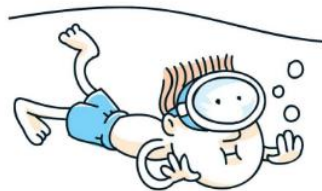
