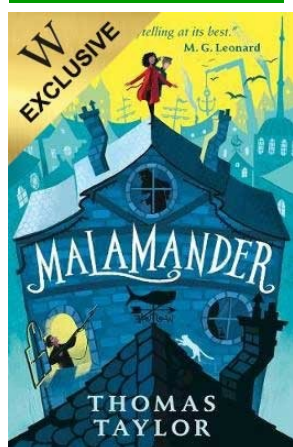
Congratulations!

Head Lice

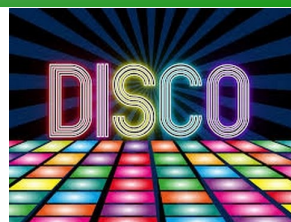
