There is still time to book a place on our new 'drop in' morning surgery sessions attended by Mr Samson and Mrs Sutton, our Home School Link Worker. The purpose of the sessions will be to answer any questions you may have over a cup of tea or coffee in our DT Kitchen area. We will also run special information segments on different matters throughout the year. The first segment will see Jackie Farrow, our Emotional Literacy Support Assistant, offer some tips on helping your child be more resilient in school and at home. The sessions will run for an hour from 9.00am on the first Monday of every month. The first session will be on Monday 4th October and if you are interested in attending then please contact the school office as spaces will be limited due to our COVID hygiene measures.

School Value

Continuing with our focus on core values, we will be concentrating on the value of RESILIENCE this term. The children will have weekly assemblies encouraging them to reflect on what this value 'looks like'. They will learn about how we all need REŚILĬENCE in order to be successful, particularly when beginning a new school year! There will also be follow up sessions in class. We also ask that they are referred to and reinforced at home as well as school. If there is anyone you feel we should be learning about who was or is a role-model for resilience then pleasé let your class teacher know!

10richment

One of the unique features of the GJS curriculum is our 10richment programme. Over the course of the year, we run 10 theme weeks which link to either a local, national or global event or day. This is a wonderful opportunity to expose children to matters that fall outside the formal curriculum and invite guests to the school, be immersed into projects and generally be creative. We will be keeping you updated when these weeks come around through the weekly newsletter, with hyperlinks to relevant websites. First up, to coincide with National Poetry Day on the 7th October, is our Poetry Week, commencing on the 4th October.
