### Air Ambulance Clothes Recycling Bin

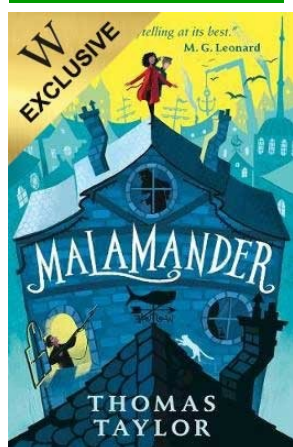
