401 Foundation Fundraiser

Last year Ben Smith, founder and CEO of the 401 Foundation, visited the school and gave an inspirational talk to the children about his battles against bullying as a child and latterly with depression as an adult and how he ran 401 marathons in 401 days to raise awareness for mental health and money for Kidscape and Stonewall charities. Since then he has started up the 401 Foundation, a grant based charity offering financial support for community projects that promote inclusion and support for young people with mental health issues. This year we are continuing our support at GJS by running 2 fundraiser events. Firstly, we will be asking the children to wear 'odd socks for £1' on Friday 25th May. The children then have the option to raise further funds by collecting sponsors to perform something 401 times over the half term holiday. This could range from swimming 401 lengths to reading 401 pages, the choice is theirs! Our aim is to raise AT LEAST £401 for the 401 Foundation. The children were made aware of the project in assembly today and we hope as many children as possible will try to raise valuable funds for this very worthy cause.
