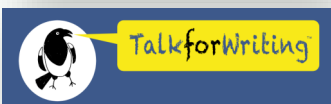
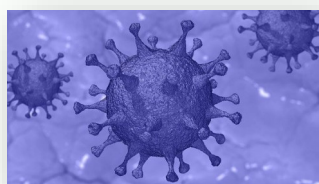

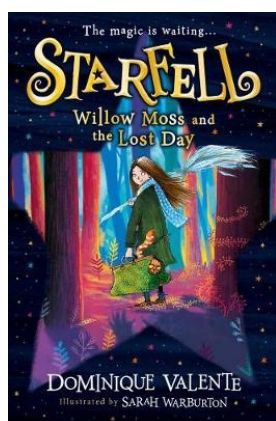

GLP Inset Days—Talk for Writing

As you were made aware in a recent newsletter, as a Godalming Learning Partnership (GLP) school, we are now part of a national project to improve children's writing called 'Talk for Writing' (TfW). This gives us access to expert input from the TfW team. Due to the pressures on the project we have had to be flexible in choosing our INSET days for next year to ensure we can gain access to the training we need. We have booked the following TfW training days for next year:

Monday 28th September—All GLP infant schools will be closed for a KS1 training day, **not GJS**

Tuesday 29th September—All GLP junior schools, will be closed for KS2 training day

Friday 26th February—All GLP schools will be closed for a TfW training day
