#### Impact of SPG spending

Evaluation of spending for the academic year 2015-16 shows

- a) High quality PE curriculum throughout the school delivered by fully qualified sports coaches. In addition, there will be CPD opportunities the sports coaches will offer to the staff to keep them up-skilled.
- b) The PE Co-ordinator has successfully planned for and taken children to the following inter-sports activities, we have also provided time for a HLTA to provide administration support:
  - GDPSSA Cross country - November
  - Year 5-6 have attended Sports hall Athletics - January,
  - Gifted and Talented sports at Broadwater School - March
  - Children attended Godalming and district Swimming Gala - March
  - District Sports - July

#### Anticipated spend for 2016-17

- From September 2016 the entire PE curriculum will return to being taught by members of school staff. The school has also forged links with Winchester University with members of the Sports Department delivering a bespoke CPD program for members of staff to up-level the PE delivery. There will be further opportunities for staff CPD which will run on a rolling program each term that will be run by the Headteacher, PE Subject Leader and/or Sports Specialist from Winchester University.
