

Coronavirus Update

You will be aware that in different parts of the country there has been a rise in Covid cases which has resulted in partial lockdowns and in a growing number of cases, partial or full school closures. Whilst we have begun the school year largely unaffected, we do insist that children are kept off school if they are poorly or if they have any of the Covid symptoms. Whilst we are not medical professionals, we are relying on everyone playing their part and using their own judgements which will continue to keep the school open and functioning and most importantly our staff safe to carry out their crucial work. We are also aware that the demand for testing is outstripping capacity and should you not be able to book a test, you must keep your child with symptoms off school for 10 days. The rest of the household, including siblings, should remain in isolation for 14 days, as the guidance states. We are fully aware how inconvenient this may be for families but it is essential that we all do what we can to keep GJS 'open for business'.
