The 2021 Olympic and Paralympic Games are being held in Tokyo and we are wanting, as a whole school, to take part in an activity challenge to Tokyo! Yes, that's Tokyo in Japan, 5,985 miles away!

The challenge this summer term is to work as a GJS team and try to accumulate together as many miles (through walking, running, cycling, scootering...) to the equivalent of travelling to Tokyo in time for the Opening Ceremony on 23rd July - just after we break up!

You will have the chance to log each activity you do on a survey form (see link below). Your activities can include (but not restricted to) walking to school, a family bike ride, a run around the park or a scoot to a friend's house. Each activity will be added together with all the pupils, families and staff at GJS, with regular updates in our newsletter.

So the question is, can Team GJS, in just the summer term, come together and travel 5,985 miles from Godalming Junior School to the Olympic Stadium in Tokyo in Japan? It's an ambitious effort, but one where we can come together and achieve!
