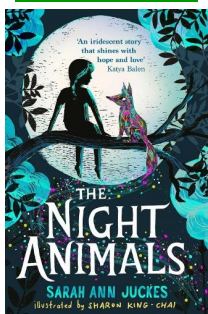
Reading Passport Resources

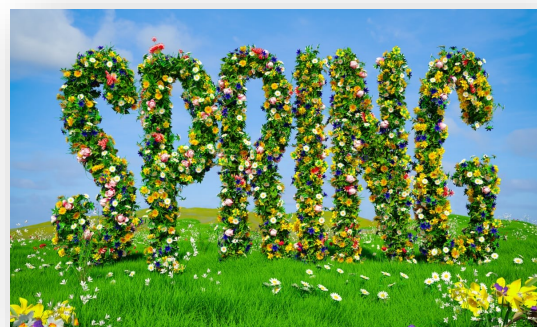
