- Passports will complement the curriculum e.g some non-fiction books linked to topics



- Some homework will be 'handed in' via Google Classroom although we will also be using Maths homework books and TTRockstars.

# Reading Expectations

- Children are expected to read at home as often as possible -logging this in the reading record at least once a week
- Only adults should comment in reading records
- Children to keep a log of what has been read in the record using the appropriate pages
- Key words the children struggle with should be logged as well
- We will endeavor to listen to all children over a fortnight and this will also be logged in your child's reading record


