Contextual Information

➤ Numbers on Roll:

- There were 60 children on roll in year 6 and all children took part in the SAT's tests
- There were 42 boys and 18 girls in year 6
- 18 children (30%) were considered either SEND, qualified for Pupil Premium support, considered EAL (English not being their first spoken language) or were a Young Carer

➤ Attendance:

- Attendance for Year 6 up until July 2026 was 98%
- Pupil Premium Year 6 pupils attendance was 93%
