

What a week we've had! Our theme of Calamitous Chemistry continued after an almost unanimous vote when classes were asked what they'd like to explore. Each year group has had a go at completing different investiga-tions where children could actually **SEE the science in action**! Year 3 made fruit volcanoes and film canister rockets! Year 4 learnt all about acids and alkaline and how these can be found using cabbage! Year 5 made rainbows using Skittles and then Year 6 created rubber eggs, explored how to get the biggest reaction out of coke and Mentos, and also looked back at their evolution and inheritance topic and how butterflies have adapted in order to ensure their survival! There have been shrieks of delight and wonder across the school and children, as always, have shown fantastic enthusiasm towards finding out WHY these reactions occur.
