Henley Fort trip

Year 4 had a fantastic visit to Henley Fort this week as part of their topic on WW2. After a long and tiring walk up The Mount in Guildford, they became ARP Wardens and Home Front Guards, dressing up in costumes and participating in range of activities that they would have completed during the War. The children were able to handle rifles and pikes, as well as practicing throwing grenades into tanks. They also experienced what it was like to direct the public into the air raid shelters, and used water pumps and hoses to put out fires. Overall, both classes really enjoyed the experience and learned a lot about what life was like in Britain during WW2.
