
## Christmas Jumper Day–Guide Dogs Fundraiser

The cost of a school meal is  $\pounds 2.60$ . If you think you may be entitled to free school meals please contact the school office. Children having packed lunches also have the option to have a school meal on a Wednesday and/or Friday. If they wish to opt in on these days, orders for all school meals will be taken by the class teacher on the day. It is SCC policy that all school meals are paid for in advance via the lunch account on Parentmail. Weekly cost = £13.00 Half term =  $\pounds72.80$ Full term = £150.80
