




- This year saw 222 responses compared to 228 in 2024
- The survey took place in the summer term 2025



I enjoy school

- 95% responded all or most of the time compared to 77% last year. ©
- 1/3 responded 'All the time' ©



What 3 words would you use to describe what it is like being a learner at GJS?

- 75% or 167 children answered FUN to this question. Other responses included:
 - > Proud
 - > Calm
 - > Active
 - > Educational
 - Exiting!HappyJoyfulCool!



Teachers help me do my best

- 90% responded all or most of the time compared to 77% last year. ©
- 56% responded that teachers help them in EVERY lesson ©



My teachers give me work that challenges me

- 76% responded all or most of the time compared to 51% last year. ©
- 20% stated this happened ALL the time ©



I enjoy learning at school

- 95% responded that they enjoy their learning most of the time compared to 81% last year.
- 42% responded that they enjoy their learning ALL the time
- Reasons why children enjoy their learning were:
 - > Teachers are kind ©
 - > Lessons are fun and challenging ©
 - > We are given fun problems to solve © > Lessons can be tricky ©

 - > Lots of different lessons ©
- However, one did respond that lessons can be boring 🕾

There is an adult to talk to if there is something worrying me

• 93% agreed there are adults to talk to compared to 86% in 2024 \odot



Behaviour

- 88% agreed that most of the time, behaviour in lessons is good compared to 92% in 2024
- Nearly 10% answered almost never is the behaviour good in lessons ⁽²⁾
- 97% agreed that the behaviour of pupils at break and lunch is good most of the time, this was the same as in 2024 ©



Safeguarding

- 96% agreed that they feel safe at GJS most of the time compared to 95% in 2024 © 66% mentioned **teachers** in their reasons why they feel safe
- Reasons the children gave for feeling safe included:
 - > Teachers on duty
 - > Regular drills and lockdowns keep us safe
 - > GJS is a safe school
 - > Teachers are really good!

Other headlines

- 98% agreed that GJS encourages children to look after their physical health ☺
- 95% agreed that GJS encourages children to look after their emotional and mental health © 12% disagreed ⊗
- 99% agreed that GJS encourages children to live up to the school values ©
 - 98% agreed that GJS encourages children to be respectful and tolerant of people from other backgrounds and treated equally ©
 - 97% agreed that teachers provide children with targets to develop skills further ©
 - 96% agreed that our 10richment weeks play a key part in our wider inclusive curriculum at GJS © International and Hero Weeks being the most popular ©
 - 98% are proud to be at GJS, 78% strongly agree ©
