Drop Off and Pick Up arrangements
Until we review the drop off and pick up times and arrangements please have consideration for our local residents and ensure they are not being blocked in or their access is not being hindered in any way and adhere to the one way systems in school. We will be reviewing the arrangements in time but until then, please respect the local residents on both Marshall Road and Hallam Road. We do ask that children make their own way to and from school where possible and that they arrive at the correct school gate at the time they are due to enter rather than waiting around at gates and creating potential 'pinch points' and unnecessary gathering. Each year group does have a 10 minute window to arrive at their designated school gate.
