

<u>COVID Update</u> From Monday 17th January, the self-isolation period is reducing. Following a negative lateral flow test on both day 5 and day 6, and children do not have a high temperature, they will be able to return to school. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to school immediately on day 6. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LF tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.
