



## Activity ideas

- Design a welcome pack for a new child taking into account they may be coming from a different country
- Read A Bundle of Sticks and then write your own story with TOLERANCE as the moral.
- Find out, research and present to the rest of the class a different race, religion or part of the world.
- As part of Black History Month, research a person with this heritage
- Create a debating club and create a set of rules including listening to each other and their opinions.
- As a class/family complete/discuss What Tolerance Means to Me
- Create a piece of art with the theme of Tolerance
- Research tolerance quotes and discuss them
- Create a musical piece called Tolerance and explain the choice of instruments, choral sounds etc.
- Create a drama sketch that encourages Tolerance in the school and the wider community.
- Learn about a prominent person alive or in history famous for showing tolerance towards others e.g. Nelson Mandela, Ghandi, Malala Yousafzai
- Read about Bible stories associated with Tolerance
