

### Living With COVID reminder

We would like to remind you of the latest guidance from the government stating that children **should** be self isolating for 3 days from a possible positive test if they experience symptoms. Though we understand that testing is only carried out by children if advised by a health professional and it is not mandatory to self isolate, we would like all members of our community to exercise caution and try to avoid attending school for 3 days or return to school when well enough.
